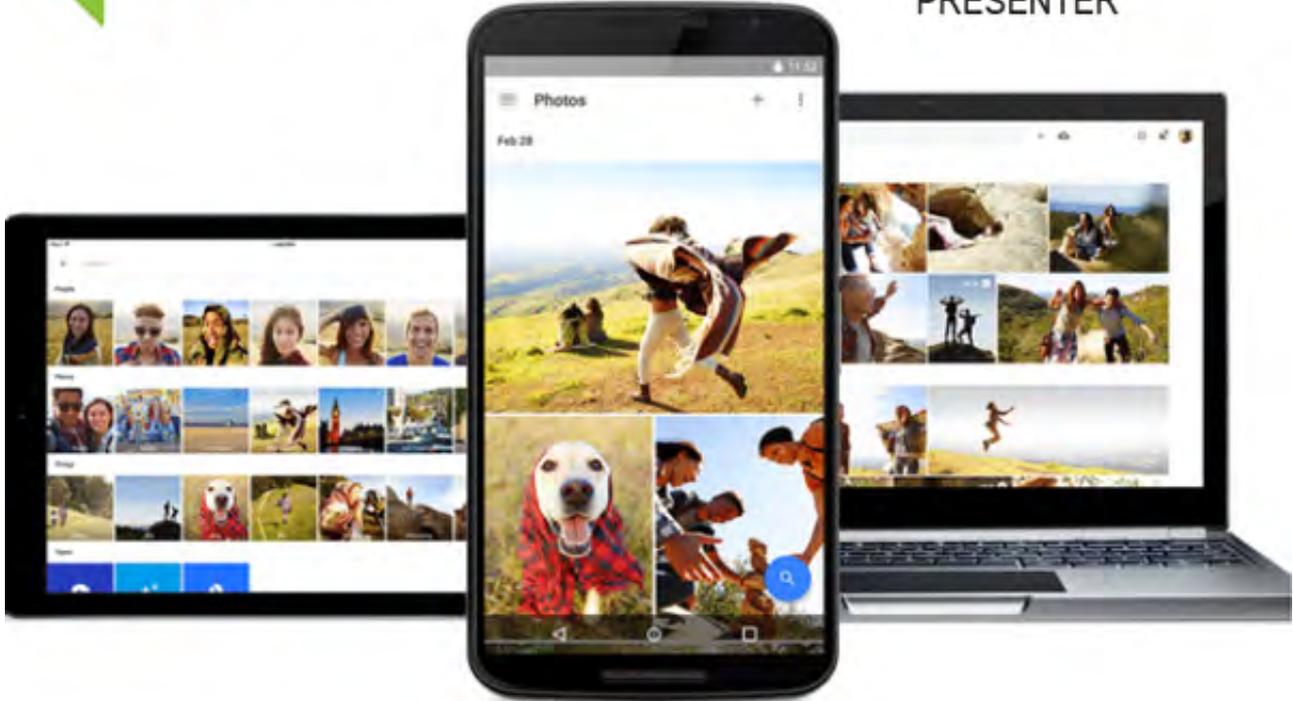

- Edit images – crop (incl. to aspect ratio), stylize filters, collage, and animated .gif.

- Albums to organise your Photo library online.
- Share selected images or huge albums with others – also choose to share all with a partner.
- Collaborate to pool images/videos of an event.
