You should be able to use this card instead of manually checking in at most Clubs, Pubs, Major Stores, and larger venues where there is someone on the door to check arrivals.

However, smaller venues will unlikely have a scanning device so you might still have to sign in.

For instance, students coming to lessons in our room who do not have a Smart Phone, will still have to sign in as Compals does not have a scanner.

It is still worth getting as this card will become more widely known and businesses will be more likely to acquire a scanner.
