How to Zip files and why

- ZIP files are intended to be compressed and therefore smaller than the original files. Yes this is a lossless process in that when you expand the ZIP file it restores copies of the original files which will be exactly the same quality/size as the original files
- Unfortunately, there isn't a simple method to make a ZIP file smaller. Once you squeeze the files to their minimum size, you can't squeeze them again. So zipping a zipped file won't do anything, and on some occasions, it can make the size even bigger.

So why use a ZIP file?

- •The best use I have found for creating a ZIP file is to collect different file types into one easy to send file by email etc.
- •There is a small saving in a zip file size compared to the total size of the individual files.
